3. Proof of Ancestry or Tribal Affiliation (i.e. Photocopy of Status Card, etc.)
4. Proof of Age (i.e. Photocopy of Birth Certificate, Drivers License, etc.)
5. Two (2) Letters of Recommendation with Letter of Recommendation Forms
6. Personal Essay
7. Letter of Support from a School Representative

Miss Manito Ahbee Youth Ambassador will be chosen based on:

- Private Interview
- Dance Competition
- Personal Essay

All contestants will be judged according to the above criterion. At the end of the Manito Ahbee Youth Ambassador event, the contestant with the highest collected points will be the new Miss Manito Ahbee Youth Ambassador for that year. The winning contestant will receive the following prizes:

Code of Conduct and General Guidelines Agreement

As a contestant for the title of Miss Manito Ahbee Youth Ambassador:

- Please remember that you represent yourself, your family, and your tribe(s).
- It would be in your best interest to conduct yourself in a manner that would reflect a positive image on yourself, your family, your tribe(s), the Miss Manito Ahbee Youth Ambassador Event, and the Manito Ahbee Pow Wow.
- It is very important for you, as a contestant and an individual, to uphold high moral standards for yourself now and in the future. This entails refraining from the use of alcohol, drugs, smoking in public, profane language, and/or outbursts of any kind. Unacceptable socializing with a partner (i.e. intimate display of affection, etc.) in public is also not allowed. Any infringement of these moral standards will result in disqualification as a Miss Manito Ahbee Youth Ambassador Contestant.
- You affirm that you have no dependents (children) nor had any children. Also, should you be selected as Miss Manito Ahbee Youth Ambassador, it would not be acceptable to cohabitate with an intimate companion.
- Maintaining a positive attitude before, throughout, and after the event is a great show of healthy character and sportsmanship. You are expected to respect, cooperate, and participate with fellow contestants, the Miss Manito Ahbee Youth Ambassador committee, judges, Manito Ahbee Pow wow staff, and with the general public.
- Punctuality is expected for all scheduled activities. You should be prepared to participate fully upon arrival.
- A parent/chaperone who is 25 years or older at registration must accompany you. Your chaperone may be your mother, aunt, grandmother, cousin, or a personal acquaintance.
- You are responsible for your personal belongings at all times. The Miss Manito Ahbee Youth Ambassador committee, Manito Ahbee Staff, and the RBC Convention Centre, are not responsible for contestant's belongings, loss of articles, theft or injury.
